- All eleven members review the applications before a committee vote is taken
- -A minimum of six yes votes are required for an application to be approved

### Our progress in 2020 has been significant in the short time since our launch

- We initiated and established the organization along with its charter
- >20 applicants have been approved and funded
- US 501(c)(3) status has been approve
- We have been able to collect over \$25,000 in funds with many repeat donors

Grew up in Ghazi Pakistan and is currently residing in High Point since 2002 along with his family of 2 children. Successful business owner.


#### **Behrose Hameed; Logistics and Committee Member** Ghazi KPK Pakistan
