As you are aware our Mission is to collect funds from Tahirkheli families located all over the world. These funds will subsequently be used to help underprivileged Tahirkheli children.

Specifically:

Tahirkheli Express aids underprivileged Tahirkheli children

- Who are under the age of 30
- Who are seeking to advance their education in professional colleges, technical diplomas, vocational courses, or IT courses

Today Tahirkheli Express has ten executive committee members

- Four in the US, Two in the UK, and Four in Pakistan
- These committee members meet weekly to review funding applications and oversee logistics including student aid payments
- We currently have one part-time admin ensuring all background checks are done and funding makes it to the right place.

Our progress to date has been significant in the short time since our launch

- 64 applicants have been approved and funded
- 3 students have graduated from their programs and are now pursuing a career
- US 501(c)(3) status has been approved
- We have been able to collect over \$40,000 in funds with many monthly donors

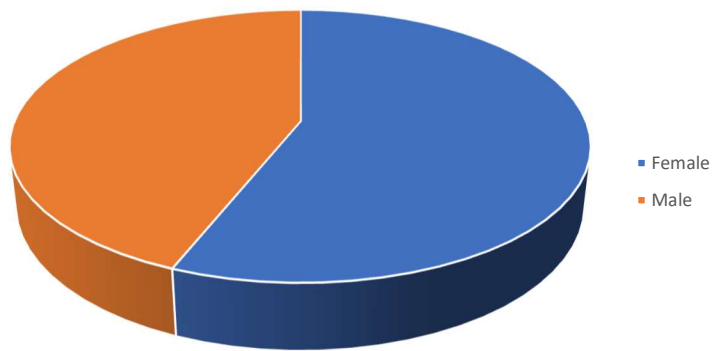

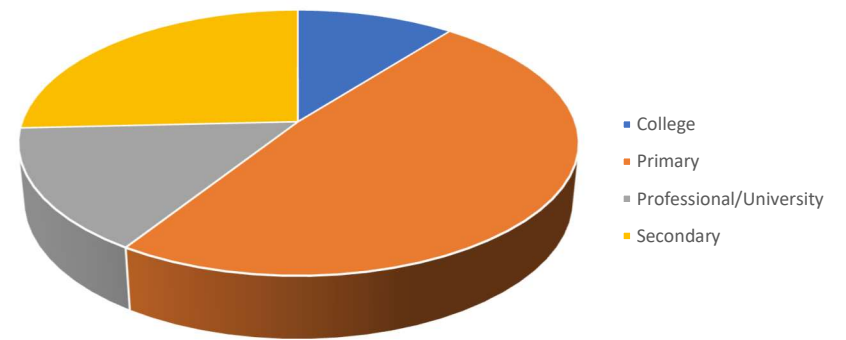

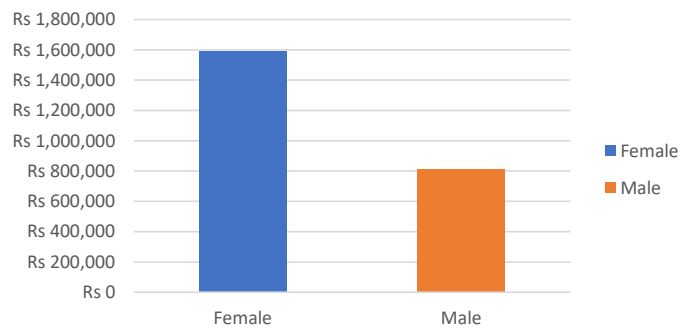
Number of Students by Gender



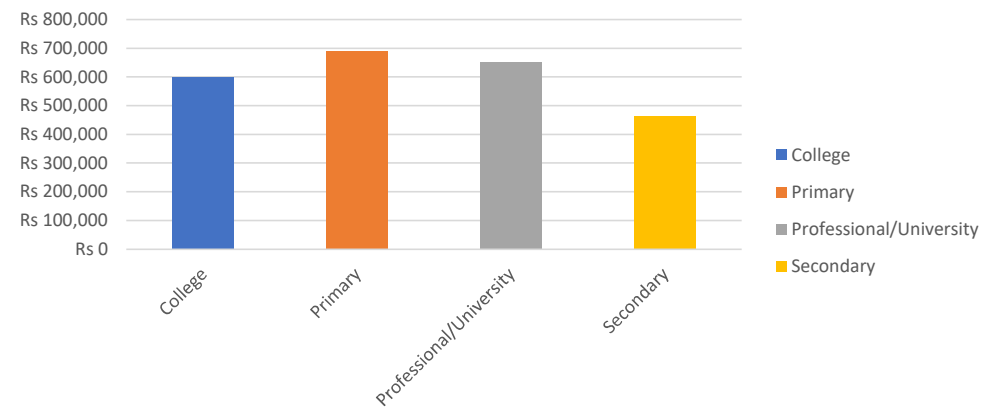
Number of Students by Class Level
